

Langhe e Roero & Torino Tour

Code 025 – 6 days

1° day

Meeting in the early morning. Lunch in a local restaurant with typical menu and well-known Roero and Langhe wines. In the afternoon, transfer to **Cherasco** and visit of this historical town: Adriani museum, Salmatoris and Gotti di Salerano Palaces and other important monuments. Free time for tasting the famous Cherasco chocolate and typical products. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

2° day

After breakfast transfer to the Langhe capital: **Alba** the city of the hundred towers. Visit de Duomo, San Lorenzo church, San Domenico church and other important monuments. Lunch in restaurant with typical menu. Transfer to **Barolo** and visit the Falletti Castle, the Wi-Mu museum and the Barolo regional wine cellar. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

3° day

After breakfast transfer to **Bra**, a charming Baroque town and visit Traversa Palace and its museum. Visit a local wine cellar with tasting. Lunch in restaurant. In the afternoon visit **Serralunga d'Alba** and its Fortress, ancient Falletti estate, one of the most beautiful and imposing ones in the area. Visit the Fontanafredda estate, nowadays famous winery, which was once the backdrop for King Vittorio Emanuele and "Bela Rosin" love story. Back to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

4° day

After breakfast transfer to **Torino** and visit the world-famous Egyptian Museum, second in importance only to the one in Cairo. Lunch in restaurant. In the afternoon walk in the center city and visit Piazza Castello, The Royal Palace, Duomo, Piazza Vittorio and Piazza

San Carlo. Free time for shopping. Back to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

5° day

After breakfast scenic Langhe tour and transfer to **Murazzano**, one of the highest point in Langhe (700 meters above sea level) and visit a dairy farm famous for the production of “toma”, a typical Piedmont cheese. Tasting. Lunch in a typical restaurant with local menu and wines. In the afternoon transfer to **Grinzane Cavour** and visit to the Castle and its wine cellar. The Castle, an imposing medieval building, was the residence of Camillo Benso, Earl of Cavour. Back to hotel, dinner and overnight.

6° day

After breakfast free time for shopping. End of service
