EGYPTIAN MUSEUM GUIDED VISIT

The Egyptian Museum is certainly a must for visitors of Turin with the new set rearrangement of Dante Ferretti.

This is the first collection in the world after the Cairo's one.

Founded in 1824, it has approximately 30,000 objects and it shows the history and civilization of Egypt, from the Paleolithic to the Coptic age, with exceptional and unique pieces including the table of Isis, the canvas painted by Gebelein, the intact tomb of Kha and Merit, the temple of Ellesjia, masterpieces of Zoser.

The extraordinary collection of large statues of pharaohs, gods and dignitaries.

The careful study of lights and colors designed by Dante Ferretti gives a unique style to this incredible collection.

The rate below includes tickets entrance. Museum's visit takes 1 and half hour, the remaining time will be used to make a city centre visit.

CINEMA MUSEUM AND MOLE ANTONELLIANA VISIT

According to the great French architect and planner Le Corbusier, Turin is the city with the most beautiful natural set. The link between Turin and the cinema is as old as the "seventh art".

Are in fact born here in 1896, the first Italian film studios where the movie “Cabiria” was shot, the first blockbuster of the story so to celebrate this ancient bond Turin has become a meeting place for the art of cinema, it houses the National Museum of Cinema in the Mole, his landmark, where the area made available by its restoration, 3,200 meters paintings on five levels, there is an organized way to areas where the visitor is the protagonist.

The exhibition areas are integrated with those of experimentation and simulation.

In the Great Hall of the temple, Chapelles are dedicated to the great themes of film history: entertainment, absurd, horror and fantasy, love and death big bang, true and false and experimental cinema.

In the museum you can admire the costume of Rodolfo Valentino in Blood and Sand, the famous bowler of Charlie Chaplin, costume and egg of the movie “Aliens”, Darth Vader's helmet and shoes, jewelry and bust of Marilyn Monroe.
